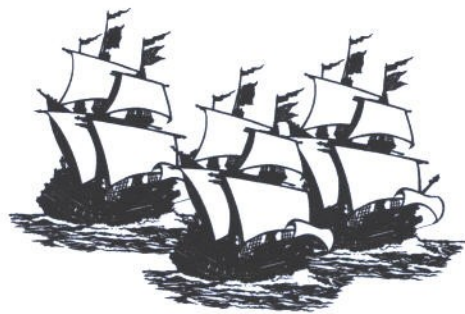
were in costume. The interaction with the Alameda group was wonderful.
